Adoption of Agenda\*

- Agenda not adopted due to quorum not reached. Schaal clarifies will continue with discussion; meeting public attendees informed of status as an unofficial meeting.

**Review Draft DDH Fundraising Letter**

- Schaal introduces the fundraising letter; ADA having been primary sponsor, ADHA was an in-kind supporter – looking to broaden sponsorship. Plans to revise the letter for generality.
  - Roner-Reiter agrees with suggestions; will forward identified typos to Kaitlyn.
  - Schaal iterates there should be more equal footing between dental, dental hygienists, specialty, and charity foundations and organizations. (e.g. National Association of Dental Plans, etc)

# DDH Dentist and Dental Hygienist Compact

- Notes question of whether letter should come from the full executive committee or commission chair.
- Dr. Bistan and Schaal plan to meet with potential sponsors soon, assessing support for funding development.
  - Schaal notes his time at Dental summit – Colorado has raised fees to fund compact enactment.
    - \$15,000 allocated for assessment, but clarifies that this is estimation does not reflect the cost of other compacts, and state assessment fees are rare.

## 1:35 p.m. **Discussion of Fiduciary Role**

- Schaal poses a question on incorporation.
  - Samantha N. notes that the nature of funds received will depend on purpose. Commission is a joint government agency; incorporation is unnecessary. IRS entitles commission to set up bank account without an Employee Identification Number.
    - Future discussions may be needed to determine directionality of funds; fulfilling fiduciary roles; contractual agreements (Memorandum of Understanding), potentially.
  - Dan L. iterates that CSG could proceed under the contract. Notes that compacts have not been undertaken as affiliate organizations but are usually transferred into secretarial roles towards independence.
    - Notes he will check with organizational leadership.
- Schaal notes RFPs for secretariat services. Asks Kaitlyn B. to follow-up.
  - Kaitlyn B. will forward similar documents from other compacts.
    - Schaal agrees and requests secretariat service providers.

## 1:45 **Review Draft Annual Report**

- Schaal notes that completion of first fiscal year, noted a couple inconsistencies (formatting, etc.) in the document, changes planned.
  - Roner-Reiter agrees and is satisfied with the report.
  - Notes interest in other compact reports detailing funding support – notes as change to be added to report.
  - Planning to meet with Drs. Bistan and Rosetto.
