Approval of Draft Meeting Minutes

- Vonda Apking moved to adopt the agenda, Corey Schaal seconded; motion carried.
- Corey Schaal moved to approve draft meeting minutes, Vonda Apking seconded; motion carried.
- The Chair noted the open secretary position.

Funding Updates

- Corey Schaal detailed a previous meeting with ADA; relays further updates from that meeting.
 - Kaitlyn Bison noted a funding proposal submitted per fundraising letters previously distributed. Proposal is still pending approval by the commission's finance committee.
 - Legal Counsel approves the procedure for formalizing acceptance of funds by the executive committee.
 - Corey Schaal moved for The Chair and Treasurer to review the proposals and follow-up with respective organizations, Vonda Apking seconded; Motion carried.

DDH Compact Timeline Discussion

- The Chair noted the upcoming full commission meeting.
- Kaitlyn Bison presented the timeline document for 3-12 months of compact development, including securing funding and rebudgeting; Rules implementation on fees, joint investigations, etc.; Data System development with Inspiring Apps.
- Corey Schaal asked about the extent of the involvement of compact connect on the data set rule.
 - Bison notes that rules committee could begin drafting, but involvement would be flexible per development of the system before the rule is finalized.
 - Schaal asks about the procedure for the appointment of Rules Committee Chair.
 - The Chair notes that Compact Connect should be involved in tandem with the dataset development process, but funding will be a continued issue.
- Corey Schaal asked about the joint investigations aspect of privilege issuances.
 - Legal Counsel notes that the Uniform Data Set Rule will detail the process for what information is shared and when in system reporting. Tiered importances.
 - Also noted – the data system vendor has been selected; however, the contract and scope of work is still needed, per development timeline and delays.
 - Item will be added to the timeline and a subsequent committee meeting.
- Corey Schaal asked about other, previous compacts' timeline for state assessment.
 - Dan Logsdon noted that PsyPact was already issuing and measure was to augment the involvement of states in compact but will soon suspend the assessment

- Legal Counsel notes that Cosmetology is developing a rule including state assessment and admin issuance fees, due to no professional association being involved and the need for additional funding. Not used for the initial development of the data system.
